Background

The 2011 Kindergarten Observation Form indicated that our incoming kindergarten students performed lower than their counterparts in the areas of self-regulation, social expression and kindergarten academics. The Marin City Health and Wellness Clinic has invited Bayside kindergarten families to attend a Health and Wellness camping trip the weekend of September 28, 2012 – September 30, 2012. Kindergarten students and their families will camp at Jellystone RV Park and Camp Resort, Cobb Mountain.

Analysis

This trip aims to educate families about the implications that physical health and mental health have on academic success. Workshop topics include: academic preparation, parent engagement, physical and mental health. Weekend outcomes include: educating Kindergarten and Pre K parents about the year-long academic expectations for their children, identification of health and mental health concerns of their families, discussion of parent engagement opportunities, engagement of families in active living/physical fitness activities, nutrition education and healthy food demonstration workshops, an increase access to high quality health care and opportunities to practice healthy behaviors.

Financial Impact

In order to participate in this learning opportunity the district would finance the cost of the bus, the bus driver and a stipend for the kindergarten teacher.


